

The County Council of Durham
(Footpath Number 13, Urpeth Parish, Hammer Square Bank, Beamish)
(Temporary Footpath Closure)
Order 2024

The Council proposes to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on the following length of footpath. A 250 metre length of Public Footpath Number 13, Urpeth Parish, extending south from Hammer Square Bank, to Footpath Number 14, Beamish. The closure is necessary to extend an emergency closure following a landslip. Alternative routes are available via established public rights of way in the area. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The closure is required from 8/11/2024 for a period of up to 6 months. On occasions, alternative dates for the closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
