## (PUBLIC FOOTPATHS NOS 1, 7 and 9 CORNSAY PARISH) PUBLIC FOOTPATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2022

On 25 October 2024, The County Council of Durham confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert **Divert a section of Public Footpath No.**1 **Cornsay Parish** from a point west-south-west of Cornsay House Farm, proceeding in a generally east-north-easterly direction across a field to the field corner **to** a line running north-easterly then south easterly to the same point in the field corner, **divert a section of Public Footpath no.** 1 **Cornsay Parish** from a point west of Cornsay House Farm, proceeding in a generally easterly direction passing to the south of the farm and to the road corner **to** a more southerly line between the same points, following the field edges, **divert Public Footpath No.** 7 **Cornsay Parish** from a point north-east of the farm, proceeding in a south-westerly direction to the farm buildings **to** a line running from the same point north-west of the farm and proceeding in a generally westerly direction to the north of the farm, crossing Footpath No. 9 and to a point on the new route of Footpath No. 1 west of the farm, **and divert a section of Public Footpath No. 9 Cornsay Parish** close to the far buildings to a slightly more easterly route to avoid a building, as shown on the order map.

A copy of the order as confirmed and the order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Esh Winning Library during normal opening hours and via the councils website.

The order comes into force as from 25 October 2024, but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 of the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 of the Act, within six weeks from 31 October 2024 make an application to the High Court.

This order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for County Durham requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

The applicant has agreed to contribute towards any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

#### BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public right of way over the land situate at Cornsay House Farm and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 7 days from the date of confirmation of this order as provided for by paragraph 3 below and thereupon the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for County Durham shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
- There shall at the end of 7 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Cornsay House Farm described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map attached to this order, and thereupon the County Durham definitive map shall be modified by adding that path to it.
- 2A. The County Durham definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. The rights conferred on the public under this order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.


