

The County Council of Durham
(Public Footpath Number 18, Riverside, Chester-le-Street)
(Temporary Footpath Closure)
Order 2024

The Council proposes to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on the following length of footpath. A 1525 metre length of Public Footpath Number 18, that extends southerly and north easterly from the southern building line at 27 to 32 The Parks, Chester-le-Street, to enable footpath surfacing works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to pedestrian traffic by way of Riverside Park peninsular permissive paths. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The closure is expected to be required from 25/11/2024 but may be subject to delays, the duration of the works is anticipated to be 3 weeks. On occasions, alternative dates for the closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
