The County Council of Durham (Bail Hill Road, Mickleton) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2024

The Council proposes to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit all vehicular traffic from proceeding on the following lengths of road. A 1955 metre length of Bail Hill Road, that extends northwards from its junction with the C161, to its junction with the road leading to Gracies Cottage, Mickleton, also incorporating the Fell Lane, Romaldkirk crossroads to enable carriageway resurfacing works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to vehicular traffic from the southern side of the closure, from the road C161 easterly to Hunderthwaite, then north easterly to Romaldkirk, and then north on the B6277 to Mickleton and the junction with Bail Hill Road, to the northern side of the closure, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are to commence from 7am on Tuesday 3/12/2024 and are anticipated to be completed in 7 days, with works being carried out up to 7pm each day. On occasions, alternative dates for the closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
