The County Council of Durham (Public Right of Way Byway Number 12 Sedgefield Parish, Yarm Lane, Sedgefield) (Temporary Byway Closure) Order 2024

The Council proposes to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit all motor vehicular and horse drawn traffic from proceeding on the following lengths of byway. A 3.3 kilometre length of Byway Number 12, also known as Yarm Lane, that extends southwards from Neasless Farm, Sedgefield, to enable re-settlement to occur, following recent repair works. An alternative route will be available to vehicular traffic and horse drawn vehicles from the northern side of the closure, from the A177 south westwards on Stockton Road then westerly toward Thorpe Leazes and Whitton, to the southern side of the closure, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The proposed works are required from Monday 9/12/2024, for a period of up to 6 months. On occasions, alternative dates for the closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
