

The County Council of Durham
(Public Rights of Way Footpath Number 7, Cassop-Cum-Quarrington
Parish, Coxhoe) (Temporary Footpath Closure)
Order 2024

The Council proposes to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on the following length of footpath. A 73 metre length of Footpath Number 7, from its inception at Park Hill and extending south westerly from its junction with Park Hill, including the gable of Number 1 Parkfield, Coxhoe, to enable sewer cleansing and CCTV survey works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to pedestrian traffic from the north eastern side of the closure, from Park Hill north, westerly onto Footpath Number 9, then north westerly and south westerly onto Footpath Number 8 leading south to the junction with Footpath Number 7, to the south western side of the closure, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The proposed works are to commence from Monday 9/12/2024 and for the duration of the works, which are anticipated to be completed in 2 weeks. On occasions, alternative dates for the closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
