

The County Council of Durham
(Public Rights of Way Footpath Numbers 46, Etherley Parish and
Numbers 112 and 125, Bishop Auckland Parish, Etherley to West
Auckland) (Temporary Footpath Closure)
Order 2024

The Council proposes to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on the following lengths of footpath in the Low Etherley and West Auckland area: **1.** a 445 metre length of Footpath Number 46 Etherley Parish that extends southwards from the B6282 Low Etherley, **2.** a 868 metre length of Footpath Number 112 Bishop Auckland Parish that extends northwards from Greenfield Roads, St Helen Auckland and **3.** a 1455 metre length of Footpath Number 125 Bishop Auckland Parish that extends southwards between Greenfields Road, St Helen Auckland and Manor Road, West Auckland, to enable footpath improvement works to be undertaken. An alternative route will not be signed to pedestrian traffic during the closures, but other routes will be available via the public right of way and highway networks. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The proposed works are required from 2/12/2024, for a period of 6 months. On occasions, alternative dates for the closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
