The County Council of Durham (Brancepeth/Raby Road, Ferryhill) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2024

The Council proposes to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit all vehicular traffic from proceeding on the following length of road. A 79 metre length of Brancepeth/Raby Road, Ferryhill from the junction with Brancepeth Road at the eastern side of the closure, proceeding in a westerly direction to the end of the cul-de-sac, to enable sewer repair works to be undertaken. Throughout the period of the closure no alternative diversion will be available to vehicular traffic, however, road plates are to be used outside of working hours. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are to commence from 8am on Monday 16/12/2024 and are anticipated to be completed in 5 days. On occasions, alternative dates for the closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
