The County Council of Durham (Public Rights of Way Byway Number 65, Consett Parish, Hamsterley Mill, Burnopfield) (Temporary Byway Closure) Order 2023

The above-named Order made by the Council on 8/9/2023, under section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and which became operational on 17/9/23 and was subsequently extended to 31/12/2024 has been continued in force from 1/1/2025, as approved by the Secretary of State for Transport, until 31/12/2025 or until completion of the works, whichever is the earlier. The effect of the Order is to temporarily close to all traffic a 22 metre length of Public Byway Number 65, Consett Parish, that extends southwards from 170 metres south of its inception at the B6310 Hamsterley Mill, to safeguard the public following a land slip. There is no signed alternative route available to traffic during the closure period.
