

The County Council of Durham
(Unclassified Road 116.19, Fell Lane, Romaldkirk)
(Temporary Road Closure)
Order 2025

The Council proposes to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit all vehicular traffic from proceeding on the following length of road. A 65 metre length of Fell Lane outside Heathercote Farm, west of Romaldkirk to enable highway drainage works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to vehicular traffic from the eastern side of the closure, from the B6277 south of Romaldkirk, south westerly on the C161 to Hunderthwaite, then west on the C161 and turning north onto Bail Hill Road, to the western side of the closure and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are to commence on Monday 20/1/2025 and are anticipated to be completed in 2 weeks. On occasions, alternative dates for the closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
