The County Council of Durham (B6313 Pelton Fell Road and North Approach, Chester-le-Street) (Temporary Road and Footpath Closure) Order 2025

The Council proposes to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit all vehicular or pedestrian traffic from proceeding on the following lengths of road and footpath, a 187 metre length of the B6313 Pelton Fell Road, from the junction with North Approach extending westerly for approximately 60 metres and easterly for approximately 100 metres and a 122 metres length of North Approach from the junction with the B6313, extending southwards for approximately 122 metres to enable surfacing works to carriageway and footways and anti-skid works to be undertaken. Throughout the period of the closure, a diversion will be available to vehicular traffic from the east side of the closure in an easterly direction on the B6313 Pelton Fell Road/North Burns/Picktree Lane, then south on the A167, then west on the C91 Ropery Lane/West Lane, then north west on South Approach/The Avenue and from west side of the closure in a westerly direction on the B6313 Pelton Fell Road, then north west on the C94 Burnthouse Bank/Front Street, then north on the C5/C4 Pelton Lane, then east on the A693, then south on the C184 Newcastle Road and vice versa, any alternative diversions for pedestrians will be signposted on site. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The proposed works are to commence from 8am on Monday 27/1/2025 and are anticipated to be completed in 5 days. On occasions, alternative dates for the closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
