The County Council of Durham (A167 A1(M) Junction 59, Coatham Mundeville) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2025

The County Council of Durham and pursuant to Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 Darlington Borough Council proposes to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit all vehicular traffic, including cycle traffic from proceeding on the following lengths of road. A 235 metre length of the A167 dual carriageway, between the access to Forest Park and Newton Park and the circulatory carriageway of the A1(M) junction 59 and Up to a 410 metre length of the A167, between its junctions with Brafferton Road and the circulatory carriageway of the A1(M) junction 59, to enable carriageway resurfacing works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to vehicular traffic from the 1. The northern side of the closure from the A167 from its junction with the B6444, northerly on the A167 to the A689 Rushyford Roundabout, then easterly on the A689 to the A1(M) junction 60 Bradbury, and vice versa. 2. Northern side of the closure from the A167 and the B6444 Roundabout, south of Aycliffe Village generally westerly on the B6444 to the A6072 at Heighington, then south on the A6072 and continuing south on the A68 to the A1(M) junction 58 Burtree, and vice versa. 3. Southern side of the closure from the A167 from its junction with Brafferton Lane, southerly on the A167 to Northgate Roundabout then westerly and north westerly on the A68 to the A1(M) junction 58 Burtree, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are required between 8pm – 6am and are to commence on Friday 24 and 31 January and Saturday 25 January and 1 February and Sunday 26 January and 2 February 2025. (The subsequent weekend will be held in reserve in case of inclement weather). On occasions, alternative dates for the closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
