The County Council of Durham (B6277 Spout Bank, Cotherstone) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2025

The Council proposes to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit all vehicular traffic from proceeding on the following lengths of road, a 980 metre length of B6277 Spout Bank that extends northwards from its junction with C162 to the junction with the access to Wodencroft. Cotherstone, to enable carriageway resurfacing works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to vehicular traffic from the northern side of the closure from B6277 north to Middleton in Teesdale then easterly and south easterly on B6282 to Eggleston then south easterly on B6278 to A67 at Barnard Castle then westerly and southerly on A67 to the Market Cross: with non HGVs continuing south and north westerly on A67 over Barnard Castle Bridge: and HGVs turning east and south easterly over Egglestone Abbey Bridge to A66 then westerly to Cross Lanes and north on B6277 to the southern side of the closure, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The proposed works are to commence on 27/1/2025 and are required between 7am and 7pm for the duration of the works anticipated to be 6 days. On occasions, alternative dates for the closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly. Access will be maintained for emergency services.
