The County Council of Durham (Oakridge Road, Ushaw Moor) (Temporary Road and Footpath Closure) Order 2025

The Council proposes to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit all vehicular and pedestrian traffic from proceeding on the following lengths of road and adjacent footpath a 454 metres length of Oakridge Road, Ushaw Moor, from the front of Number 24 to the front of Number 125 Oakridge Road and the junction with Broom Crescent to enable carriageway reconstruction works to be undertaken. Throughout the period of closure, a diversion will be available to vehicular and pedestrian traffic from the north side of closure in a northerly direction on Oakridge Road, then west on Victoria Court, then south on Whitehouse Lane, then south west on Broom Lane, then north on Valley View and west on Broom Crescent to southern end of closure and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The proposed works are to commence at 8am on 3/2/2025 and anticipated to be completed in 6 weeks. On occasions, alternative dates for the closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
