## The County Council of Durham (A181 and Unc 27.8 Shincliffe Lane, Sherburn House) (Temporary Weight Restriction) Order 2025

The Council on 10/1/2025 made the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to restrict all vehicular traffic over the weight limit specified below from proceeding on the following lengths of road.

Vehicles over 18 Tonne a 40 metre length of the A181 that extends north westwards from 10 metres north west of the access to the sewage works. Vehicles over 7.5 Tonne on Unclassified road 27.8 Shincliffe Lane between its junctions with the A181 Sherburn House and the B1198 for public safety and to enable bridge repair works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be signed to affected vehicular traffic from the southern side of the closure from B1198 / A181 easterly to Byers Garth Roundabout then northerly on C12a Mill Lane top Sherburn Village then westerly on B1283 to the junction with A181 to the northern side of the closure, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 18 months. The order is required from 10/1/2025 for a period of 18 months or until the bridge is repair and safe to reopen to all traffic. On occasions, alternative dates for the closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
