The County Council of Durham (St Marys Close, Bishop Auckland) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2025

The Council proposes to make an Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, to prohibit all pedestrian traffic from proceeding on the following length of footpath. A 45 metre length of segregated footpath from Numbers 1 to 16 St Marys Close and Numbers 42 to 44 Abbey Road, Bishop Auckland to enable street lighting column and supply renewal works to be undertaken. An alternative route will be available to pedestrian traffic from the southern side of the closure from Abbey Road, easterly and northerly onto Vart Road, then north westerly onto Hardisty Crescent and south westerly onto St Marys Close to the northern side of the closure, and vice versa. The maximum duration of the Order is 6 months. The proposed works are to commence on Monday 3/2/2025 and are anticipated to be completed in 2 weeks. On occasions, alternative dates for the closure may be necessary and these will be signed on site accordingly.
