## Environment Act 1995 Part IV Section 83 (2) Durham County Council AQMA Order

Durham County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 83(2) of the Environment Act 1995, hereby makes the following Order to amend the Durham County Council Air Quality Management Area (Durham City) (No 1) Order 2011.

This Order may be cited as the Durham County Council Air Quality Management Area (Durham City) (No.2) Order and shall come into effect on 25<sup>th</sup> July 2014

The shaded area shown in purple on the attached map is the city centre Air Quality Management Area designated by the Durham County Council Air Quality Management Area (Durham City) (No 1) Order 2011 that came into effect on 9<sup>th</sup> May 2011 and further areas of New Elvet, Claypath and the west end of the city. The further extended areas incorporate the roads, pavements and properties on the attached schedule of the following:

- (i) The A690 west to east route though Durham City from the Stonebridge roundabout (Broom Lane), Neville's Cross, the Peth to the Crossgate Lights junction, Alexandria Crescent and Sutton Street to join the western boundary of the existing designated Air Quality Management Area;
- (ii) A section of New Elvet to the junction of Hallgarth and Church Street; and
- (iii) A section of Claypath from Leases Road that is within the existing designated Air Quality Management Area to the junction with Providence Row.

The attached schedule is a list of properties within the revised Air Quality Management Area.

The designated area shall include any future dwellings within or adjacent to the area marked on the attached map.

This area is designated in relation to a likely breach of the nitrogen dioxide (annual mean) objective as specified in the Air Quality Regulations 2000 and Air Quality (Amendment) Regulations 2002.

This Order shall remain in force until it is varied or revoked by a subsequent order.
