

Durham County Council Air Quality Management Area (Chester le Street) (No.2) Order 2015

Durham County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995, hereby makes the following Order to amend the Durham County Council Air Quality Management Area (Chester le Street) (No 1) Order 2013.

This Order may be cited as the Durham County Council Air Quality Management Area (Chester le Street) (No.2) Order and shall come into effect on the date on which this Order is sealed.

The effect of this Order shall be to amend the boundary of the designated Air Quality Management Area to solely include Menceforth Cottages. The amended designated area shaded in purple on the attached map incorporates the road, pavements and properties detailed on the attached schedule, comprising of the row of terraced properties known as Menceforth Cottages, that are situated on Pelton Fell Road to the west of Chester le Street town centre.

The designated area shall include any future dwellings in or adjacent to the area marked.

This Area is designated in relation to a likely breach of the nitrogen dioxide (annual mean)] objective as specified in the Air Quality Regulations 2000 and Air Quality (Amendment) Regulations 2002.

This Order shall remain in force until it is varied or revoked by a subsequent order.
