

Please don't put white goods (such as fridges/ fridge-freezers, washing machines/dryers or dishwashers) in your yard or garden for unlicensed waste carriers to collect. They could end up flytipped.

Arrange a bulky waste collection* and we'll make sure they're collected and recycled correctly.

Recycle white goods right

- Call us on 03000 261 000 to book a bulky waste collection.
 Please put your item out by 7am on your booked collection day only. This stops items being taken by unlicensed waste carriers.
 Visit www.durham.gov.uk/bulkywaste for further details.
- Donate items (in good condition) to family/friends or reuse charities. For a list of reuse charities visit www.durham.gov.uk/reuse or call 03000 261 000.
- Take items to your local household waste recycling centre (HWRC). If you use a van, pick-up, mini-bus or trailer, you'll need to apply for a free waste permit beforehand. Visit www.durham.gov.uk/householdpermit or call 03000 261 000.

Did you know? Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) Regulations

When you buy a new electrical white goods item, your retailer may offer to collect and dispose of your old item when they deliver your new item. Charges may apply. Ask your retailer to arrange this.
