Mm, yes. The funniest was probably one of, mm, Rifleman Mullins' quiz nights every Wednesday or Thursday night, I can't remember what night he used to put a quiz on, and we all used to have a good laugh at them like. Mm, but I haven't really got many like stories that will make you fall off your chair laughing because there's not much, sometimes, I think most of the time you just want to sleep or, or go to the gym and stuff like that. Mm, probably one of the worst things that happened to me out there was, mm, we got, we were going through the Green Zone, I think it was the first time we went through the Green Zone we got ambushed and there was like two platoons in the killing area and, mm, one of the lads in my section got hit, Rifleman Baker, he got shot in the back, mm, and he sort of fell into an irrigation ditch and his body was upside down, his face must have been about two inches away from the water. So like and with all the contact reports going on and stuff like that and all the firing, mm, it sometimes takes a while for whoever's next to you to alert you that there's a casualty. Mm, as soon as I got alerted and I seen him like he was upside down, mm, I picked him up and so he was telling us that he couldn't feel his legs and stuff. Mm, there was blood on his trousers but I couldn't really, I couldn't find where the wound was, I had to take his trousers off him and stuff like that. Mm, but it was in his lower back. You could just see him his colour changing and all that stuff. Mm, that was probably the worst experience like.
