Mm, it, first time I stepped back on, like stepped foot on like British ground is it was a bit 'yes, I'm finally home, I'm excited, yes, yes'. And then you get home and that and there's like for meself, I don't know about anyone else, I got home and that and there was a lot of people there and I was a bit scared. It was like 'I don't really know yous any more'. It's like six months of my life and your life that we haven't known each other and that and I can't, and stepped outside and sat by myself because I was used to doing stuff like that. And like it was just, I don't know it just felt really weird having to like sit and talk to people who were in like civvies and that and watch TV, watch programmes and that and sit down and have a laugh and see a cat that doesn't need to be shot or something like that. Mm, so yes it was really weird and that and it took me a while to adjust back to civvy like, like back to UK life and that. But I eventually got there, although it was hard.
